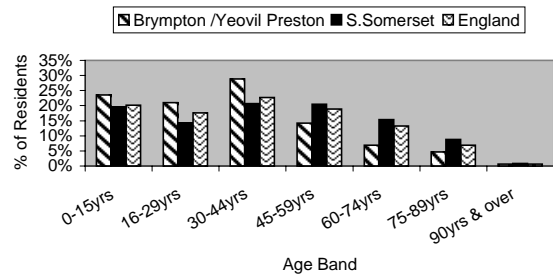

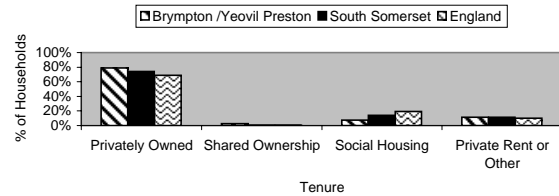

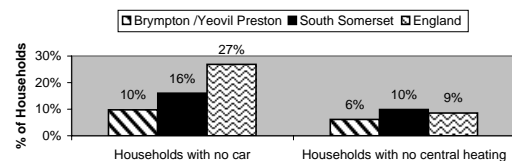

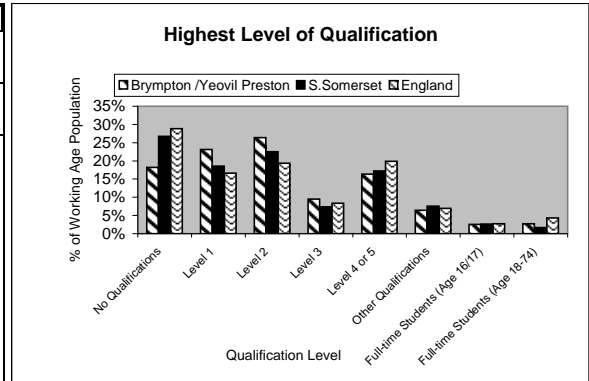

### 10. Index of Multiple Deprivation 2004

This is a measure of deprivation for Super Output Areas (SOAs). Super Output Areas contain 1000-1500 residents and so data is more detailed and representative than Ward level data. It can reveal differences within Wards as well as between Wards. There are 103 SOAs in South Somerset and 32,482 SOAs in England. Each SOA is assigned a rank, rank 1 is the most deprived thus SOAs with a low rank number are more deprived than SOAs with a higher rank number.
