

**WINCANTON NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN
DECISION STATEMENT (PROCEEDING TO REFERENDUM)
08/12/2017**



1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The area for the Wincanton Neighbourhood Plan comprises the whole of the parish of Wincanton. In March 2014, South Somerset District Council formally agreed that the Wincanton Neighbourhood Area be designated in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.
- 1.2. Wincanton Town Council – the ‘qualifying body’, submitted the draft Wincanton Neighbourhood Plan, along with supporting documents, to South Somerset District Council in April 2017 for consultation, independent examination and the remaining stages of the draft Plan’s preparation in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.
- 1.3. Following submission of the draft Wincanton Neighbourhood Plan, South Somerset District Council publicised the Plan and supporting documents and invited representations during the six week consultation period between 15th June 2017 and 27th July 2017.
- 1.4. In August 2017, South Somerset District Council appointed an independent examiner, Jill Kingaby to examine the Plan and consider whether it should proceed to referendum.
- 1.5. The examiner’s report was received in November 2017 and concluded that subject to making the modifications recommended in the report, the draft Plan meets the Basic Conditions and should proceed to referendum. The examiner also recommended that the Wincanton Neighbourhood Area (the parish area) is an appropriate area within which to hold a referendum.
- 1.6. In accordance with legislation, South Somerset District Council must consider the recommendations made in the examiner’s report, decide what action to take in response to each recommendation and what modifications should be made to the draft Plan in order to be satisfied that it meets the Basic Conditions and is compatible with Convention Rights. If the authority is satisfied then a referendum must be held. Consideration also needs to be given as to whether to extend the area to which the referendum is to take place.

2. DECISION

- 2.1. Having considered the examiner’s recommendations and reasons for them, the Council concurs with the examiner’s view and at the District Executive meeting on 7th December 2017, it was agreed that modifications to the draft Wincanton Neighbourhood Plan should be made in accordance with examiner’s recommendations, to ensure that it meets legal requirements including the Basic Conditions as set out in legislation.
- 2.2. The Council is satisfied that the Neighbourhood Plan, as modified, complies with the legal requirements and can proceed to referendum.
- 2.3. The Council also agrees with the examiner that the referendum area should reflect the extent of the Wincanton Neighbourhood Area.
