Public Space Protection Order

Intimidation, alarm, harassment or distress

South Somerset District Council (the Council) is satisfied that intimidation, alarm, harassment or distress is being carried out within the area to which this Order applies or it is likely that this activity will be carried out and this is having or it is likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality and it therefore makes this Public Spaces Protection Order ("PSPO") covering the matters as set out below.

This PSPO relates to all that public place outlined in red on the attached map and which is briefly described in the Schedule.

The activities set out in this PSPO are prohibited or required only where an authorised person requires a person to stop the activity or requires that person to do something as set out in this Order.

- An authorised person means a constable, a police community support officer or a person authorised in writing by the Council.
- A public place means any place to which the public or any section of the public has access, on payment or otherwise, as of right or by virtue of express or implied permission.

The activities which are prohibited or required by this PSPO are;

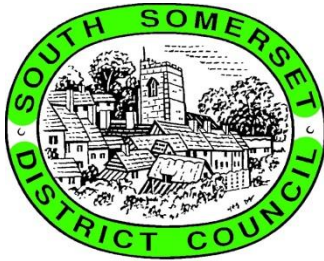
1. All persons are prohibited from behaving in a manner that intimidates, alarms harasses or distresses either individually or as a group a member or members of the public in a public space.

Where an authorised person reasonably believes that a person or group of people;

- is or has behaved in a manner that intimidates, alarms harasses or distresses or
- intends to behave in a manner that intimidates, alarms harasses or distresses

the authorised person can require the person or group of people to disperse immediately or within a specified time.

2. An authorised person who imposes a requirement under paragraph 1 must tell the person that failing without reasonable excuse to comply with the requirement is an offence.

3. Offences

- a. A person who behaves in a manner that intimidates, alarms, harasses or distresses or fails without reasonable excuse to comply with an authorised person's request to not behave in a manner that intimidates, alarms, harasses or distresses in a public space commits an offence under Section 67 of the Act and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Level 3 on the standard scale.

- b. An authorised person may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice under Section 68 of the Act to anyone who he or she believes has committed an offence by not complying with a requirement of this Order. You will have 14 days to pay the fixed penalty of £80, reduced to £50 if paid within 10 days. If you pay the fixed penalty within the 14 days you will not be prosecuted.

4. This PSPO shall come into effect on **DATE**.

5. This PSPO shall have effect for a period of 3 years.

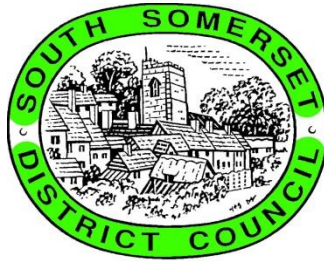
