

Origami chicks



Get creative this Easter by making some origami chicks. This simple craft will bring colour and festivity to your household.

You will need:

Coloured card,
Pencil,
Scissors,

Glue,
Feathers / leaves
Hole punch (optional)

- 1 Trace a round a circular object such as a tea plate on your chosen card. We have used yellow card but you could use other colours or even patterned card if you would like to. You could even try out a variety of circular sizes for different sized chicks.
- 2 Cut around the circle. It is best to do this by moving the paper instead of the scissors.
- 3 Fold the circle in half and crease it to make a semi circle.
- 4 Cut out two circles from black card for eyes, alternatively you could use a hole punch to make sure they are the same size. You could also consider using googly eyes or beads.
- 5 Cut a triangle for the beak. This can be in any colour card, we have chosen orange. Remember the beak will be folded in half so make sure the triangle is big enough to be folded.
- 6 Next, stick the chicks eyes on. Place the eyes on either side of the folded line to the edge of the circle.
- 7 Fold the beak in half and attach to the underside of the yellow circle between the chicks eyes. Make sure the folded creases line up.
- 8 Forage in the garden for some feathers or leaves which make great wings. Stick these onto either side of the chicks body.
