Sections 2, 8, 9 & 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework Feb 2019 refer to the importance of considering crime & disorder at the planning stage. Paragraph 127(f) states;

Create places that are safe, inclusive and accessible and which promote health and well-being, with a high standard of amenity for existing and future users and where crime and disorder, and the fear of crime, do not undermine the quality of life or community cohesion and resilience.
