This is a joint response from Paul Haines and Michelle Haines. We are former residents of Ilminster and still have considerable interest in the Ilminster Neighbourhood Plan Regulation 16.

We are responding to the Ilminster Neighbourhood Plan Regulation 16 and we wish to make the following comments.

We very surprised to see that Shudrick Valley is once again mentioned for development.

In Question 1. Policy Ilminster. The amount and location of any new homes should be reinstated into the plan.

In Question 2. We are opposed to the Ilminster Neighbourhood Plan following the removal of all sites after Regulation 14 consultation. The plan should not go Referendum unless, it has been revised to include development sites based on the Regulation 14 consultation responses from the community, which showed resounding opposition to Shudrick Valley sites. We think that there is currently no shared vision for the future of Ilminster because of serious lack of consultation and the community not being kept up to date or properly engaged during the plan's progress.

In Question 3. Development sites should be reinstated based on the responses made by the community during the Regulation 14 consultation.
